Heart:

Look again at the qualities Paul emphasizes in this passage. What might each trait reveal about the challenges or temptations common to those life stages?

How do verses 3 - 5 demonstrate the link between godly character and teaching others? What is the biblical version of "discipleship" here?

Which of the traits listed most needs growth in you right now?

If you are in a position to teach or model your faith to others, do you do so with humility and consistency? Why would humility and consistency be important?

Think about the upcoming week, your appointments, obligations, work schedule, family activities, etc. How can you create space this week to *practice* one of these traits - intentionally, prayerfully, and with dependence on God's grace?
